Where we work: Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan

In Central Asia, we work with governments, civil society and the private sector to enhance regional collaboration, tackle social divisions and address environmental challenges to increase resilience across the region.



We support:

- Actors that work to strengthen Inter-community social cohesion and trust between civil society and governments
- Regional cooperation to address social and environmental through collective civil society and private sector initiatives

Southeast Asia

Where we work: Myanmar

In Southeast Asia we are focused on Myanmar, where we partner with civil society organisations and pro-democracy actors to develop federal democratic governance and transitional justice efforts.



We support:

- Local political processes on federal democracy and transitional justice that are inclusive of minorities and promote trust between different ethnic groups
- Efforts to ensure international support to Myanmar's local political processes is inclusive, conflict-sensitive, and responsive to local needs

West Africa

Where we work: Benin, Burkina Faso, Niger, Senegal

In West Africa, we partner with national and regional actors to strengthen dialogue between different communities, the state and the private sector to counter violent escalation and promote inclusive governance and development.



We support:

- Local and international actors working to increase collaboration between different communities to strengthen cohesion and prevent the escalation of violence.
- Multistakeholder mechanisms and dialogues around the inclusive management of natural resource to reduce grievances that fuel violence.

Western Balkans

Where we work: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia

In the Western Balkans, we work towards reconciliation by supporting inclusive and responsive collaboration across ethnic lines within and across states.



We support:

- Actors that promote Inter-ethnic collaboration and improve trust within states and at the regional level
- Multi-perspective dialogue that encourages societies to deal with the past responsively and inclusively

International Programme

Our work with international partners leverages their impact for stronger peacebuilding outcomes at the local level, and/or enables them to integrate conflict sensitivity and peacebuilding in their work. Through tailored support, we strengthen their ability to deliver their mandate and contribute to peace and cohesion in fragile contexts.



We support:

- International organisations with a peacebuilding mission to change their practices to more directly contribute to inclusive and locally-led peacebuilding in and beyond our focus regions
- International organisations with a humanitarian, development or environmental mission change how they work to mitigate conflict risks and scale up their contribution to peacebuilding, including by strengthening the level and quality of their support to local actors in our focus regions.
- Companies and investors to contribute to a just energy transition and foster constructive business-community relations in fragile states by strengthening conflict sensitive business practices and supporting inclusive dialogue initiatives.
